# COCKTAIL PITCHERS




We pride ourselves on creating unique craft cocktails that appeal to all audiences and are made with locally sourced ingredients. From hand-juiced citrus to freshly made syrups, we go the extra mile to make delicious cocktails that show off our unique spirits.

Our menu currently consists of cocktail pitchers to be shared between 1-4 guests. Half pitchers make 2 cocktails, while full pitchers make 4 cocktails. We're not offering single cocktails at this time.

Please note that outside beer, wine, and spirits are not allowed in our space.

# LOCATION



We're located in the heart of the Fermentation District in Everett, MA. Nestled in between Night Shift Brewing and Bone up Brewery, Short Path Distillery is easily accessible from all major routes including Route 93, and just a short walk from Wellington Station on the Orange Line. We don't offer dedicated parking but there's plenty of free street parking around the area.

# FAQ

**Q: How much does a private rental cost?**

**A:** Our pricing varies depending on the day of week, timeframe, and number of guests. Please contact us directly for a quote.

**Q: Can I bring in my own food?**

**A:** No, food must be ordered through our partner restaurant, The Village Bar & Grill. We will help coordinate your order in advance.

**Q: How do I make a reservation?**

**A:** Please contact us directly to start the booking process. We require a 25% downpayment to reserve your event date. The remaining balance is due two weeks prior to your event date.

**Q: Can I bring in outside beer, wine, or spirits?**

**A:** Unfortunately, no. Our license permits us to only serve spirits that we produce onsite. No outside alcohol is allowed. We appreciate your understanding.

**Q: Can I bring decorations?**

**A:** Yes, as long as nothing is tacked onto the walls.

**Q: Can I bring guests who are under 21 to my event?**

**A:** Yes, as long as they are accompanied by a legal guardian or parent.
